	Create your online fundraising page (optional) - add your photo, your story, and fundraising
	goal
	Decide how you will promote your fundraiser - e.g. via social media, email, local newspaper,
	workplace, social groups
	Submit any additional promotional materials you create to TKCP for approval
	Thank your supporters as donations come in!

3. After you've finished fundraising

Thank your supporters! Share with them your final result
Forward funds raised to TKCP
Return any collection tins/raffle books or unsold merchandise to The Kids' Cancer Project
You're done! Celebrate and be proud of what you have done to support childhood cancer
research
